Getting Started with the PureContact™

Removing and inserting the PureContactTM in the rubber boot

- To remove the PureContactTM from the boot, push back on the top of the rubber boot to remove the PureContactTM
- To insert the PureContactTM into the boot, push the bottom of the PureContactTM into the bottom of the boot then push the top of the PureContactTM into the top of the boot. The PureContactTM fits snuggly into the boot



Inserting the battery into the PureContact

• Once the PureContactTM is removed from the boot, turn the PureContactTM over onto the back side and gently pull the battery compartment cover towards you. This opens the compartment.



- The PureContactTM requires one high quality 9 volt battery such as Duracell or Energizer brands. Some brands do not provide a full 9 volts of power which may result in missed shots or lower accuracy levels. You can use an alkaline or lithium ion 9 volt battery. Lithium ion batteries will provide approximately 20 hours of use whereas alkaline batteries will provide approximately 4-5 hours of use. The Battery icon will display on the screen when the battery is getting low and should be replaced.
- As you insert the battery, ensure the + sign on the battery lines up with the + inside the battery compartment. Incorrect placement of the negative (-) and positive (+) contact points may damage the PureContact.

• Once the battery has been properly inserted, close the battery compartment by sliding the cover into place.



• Put the PureContactTM back into the boot.

Opening and closing the stand

• The PureContactTM stand is attached to the boot. The stand snaps against the boot when storing.



• When the PureContactTM is in use, the stand is pulled away from the boot allowing the PureContactTM to stand upright.





Powering on the PureContactTM


- Press the Power key once to power on the PureContactTM.
- The unit will automatically power off after 10 minutes of idle time.

Changing the default distance units

- The PureContactTM is defaulted to Carry Yards. To change the default to Carry Meters; power the PureContactTM off then press Function and Power at the same time.
- Push Function until the correct distance units display then press Power. This will save your distance units setting and power off the PureContactTM.

Positioning the PureContactTM

- Place the PureContactTM on the ground/floor with the stand extended.
- Face down range (so the display and buttons are facing directly down range) and power on the unit.
- Next, move the PureContactTM 8-12 inches to the side of the ball in a straight line between the golfer, ball and PureContactTM then move the PureContactTM forward (down range) 8-12 inches.
- For right handed players, the PureContactTM would be placed 8-12 inches to the right and in front of the ball with the unit display facing towards down range.
- For left handed players, the unit would be placed 8-12 inches to the left and in front of the ball. See the diagram below.





Using the PureContact™

Setting the Band for Faster Swing Speed Golfers

• To ensure the most accurate readings, set the band for the club you are using. Push the Function button until the appropriate band is displayed on the screen. Use the table below to select the correct band. Bands 2-12 reflect carry distance

Band	Which Club Should Be Hit In This Band?
1	Driver (Total Yards)
2	Driver and Fairway Woods
3	2 or 3 Iron and 2 or 3 Hybrid
4	4 Iron or 4 Hybrid
5	5 Iron or 5 Hybrid
6	6 Iron
7	7 Iron
8	8 Iron
9	9 Iron
10	Pitching Wedge or Sand Wedge over 125 yards
11	Pitching Wedge or Sand Wedge between 100-125 yards
12	All Shots under 100 yards

Setting the Band for Moderate to Slow Swing Speed Golfers

• To determine whether you should use the Moderate or Faster Swing Speed Bands hit a shot with your 5 Iron with the Band set to 5. If your displayed ball speed is less than 105 MPH then use the following table for setting your bands

Band	Which Club Should Be Hit In This Band?	Carry/Total
1	Do not use	Do not use
2	Driver and Fairway Woods	Carry
3	2 or 3 Iron and 2 or 3 Hybrid	Total
4	4 Iron or 4 Hybrid	Total
5	5 Iron or 5 Hybrid	Total
6	6 Iron	Total
7	7 Iron	Total
8	8 Iron	Carry
9	9 Iron	Carry
10	Do not use	Do not use
11	All Wedge shots over 100 yards	Carry
12	All Shots under 100 yards	Carry



Viewing the Results

• After hitting a shot, the PureContactTM will display two numbers on the screen. The top number is your distance and the bottom number is your ball speed for the shot. See the illustration below

Warranty

This warranty applies only to the original purchaser of this product.
